



**BYLAW NO. 1066  
OF STARLAND COUNTY  
IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, CANADA**

---

A Bylaw of Starland County, in the Province of Alberta, Canada, to establish the due date for the payment of outstanding general accounts payable to Starland County, and to provide for interest charges on overdue accounts.

**WHEREAS**, Section 7 of the Municipal Government Act, being Chapter M-26.1 of the Statutes of Alberta, notes that a Council may pass bylaws for municipal purposes that relate to services provided by or on behalf of the County.

**AND WHEREAS**, the Council feels that in order to encourage the timely payment of accounts payable to the municipality, that delinquent or late payments should be subject to an additional interest penalty charge.

**NOW THEREFORE**, the Council of Starland County, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

**SECTION 1**

- 1.1 That all general accounts payable to Starland County become due and payable 30 days from the date of the mailing of the statement of account.
- 1.2 That an interest charge of one and one half percent (1.5%) per month be imposed on general accounts payable to Starland County remaining unpaid 30 days from the date of mailing of the statement of account.

**SECTION 2            EFFECTIVE DATE**

- 2.1 This Bylaw shall come into force and effect on the final date of passing thereof.
