Starland County is seeking a Temporary Full Time Labourer in our Municipal Services Department who will be responsible for maintaining the water stations in the hamlets and villages within Starland County as well as assisting the Utility Operators and Municipal Services Director with tasks. The job duties will include, but are not limited to the following:

- ✓ Weed whipping and mowing around the water station sites within the County
- ✓ Clean any debris/garbage from areas prior to mowing
- ✓ General maintenance on equipment as needed
- ✓ Help with daily on-site tasks related to the recreation department
- ✓ Assist in maintaining the grounds of recreational facilities and other properties owned by Starland County
