	Scentless Chamomile and Yellow Toadflax Incentive Policy	September 11, 2024	C24-232

PURPOSE:

Scentless Chamomile and Yellow Toadflax are two common weeds in Starland County that have the potential to spread quickly in years with favorable growth conditions. To encourage weed control by landowners, Starland County will provide an incentive in the form of a reduced rate for control performed by municipal staff.

PROCEDURE:

Starland County will provide landowners with a 60% cost reduction of the total invoiced amount for the control of Scentless Chamomile or Yellow Toadflax, up to a maximum of \$500 per farming unit.

This incentive will only apply to any work completed by Agricultural Services staff. All projects must be inspected and approved by the Agricultural Fieldman for the incentive to take effect.
