SUMMARY OF POSITION:

The Seasonal Geographic Information Systems (GIS) Support will assist the Asset Management & GIS Specialist with field data collection, asset inspections, and basic GIS and records support. This role involves working outdoors to gather and verify asset information for municipal infrastructure.

RECOMMENDED TRAINING & QUALIFICATIONS:

- Currently enrolled or recently completed a post-secondary program in Asset Management, Geographic Information System (GIS), Geography, Engineering Technology, computer science, or other relevant field
- Valid Class 5 Drivers License
- Understanding of GIS Software – ArcGIS, QGIS
- Excellent verbal & written communication and collaboration skills
- Ability to work outdoors in varying weather conditions
- Strong attention to detail and willingness to learn
- Microsoft Office Applications - Word, Excel, Outlook, Sharepoint, etc.
- Safety Training: including Safety Orientation, First Aid, WHMIS 2015, others as applicable

KEY DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. **GIS Functions:**
 - a) Assist with field data collection and verification of municipal assets
 - b) Accompany staff during asset inspections and condition assessments
 - c) Collect photos, measurements, and location data using mobile devices and mapping tools
 - d) Assist with updating asset and GIS databases under staff direction
 - e) Support basic mapping and data organization activities
 - f) Ensure collected data is accurate, complete, and properly documented
 - g) Follow all municipal safety policies and procedures
 - h) Provide ongoing support to the Asset Management & GIS Specialist

WORKING CONDITIONS:
