Resignation of G. Doering

Assistant CAO Bremer advised Council that a letter of resignation of employment had been received from the County's Heavy Duty Mechanic, Greg Doering. This position will be advertised as soon as possible.

Attendance of Manager Riep & Municipal Services Report At 9:40 a.m., Manager Riep attended the meeting and reviewed his Municipal Services Report with Council. Highlights of his report included the following:

- The inventory count has been completed for 2011;
- The heater was repaired in the Michichi Washhouse;
- The Craigmyle Lift Station required repairs as the pumps were cycling due to faulty floats;
- They had to pull the distribution pump on the CLV line for maintenance and repair;
- The electrical inspection has now been completed for the Michichi Washhouse;
- Further discussions have been held with regards to the Morning Glory Water Co-op and their interest in the County operating their system for them. Their board of directors voted to proceed with the County's most recent proposal which would require some

upgrading to components of the system to allow the County to operate the system within the provincial code of practice regulations. These modifications would include the incorporation of meter vaults at each service connection with regulated flow and isolation valves and installation of at least two main flushing hydrants at the most outward points of the system. These capital costs would be the responsibility of the membership and operating expenses would be evaluated once the system is operating under the County;

 Manager Riep outlined three possible sites that the Munson Truckfill Station could be established at. All three sites are in close proximity to the waterlines and all have access to power. He will continue to investigate the sites identified and possible property securement and will provide a detailed project description for the truckfill station construction and development plan at the next council meeting for Council's review.

Formation of a Regional Emergency Management Committee Manager Riep also reviewed the draft documents in regards to the formation of a Regional Emergency Management Committee. He reviewed the *Terms of Reference* for the Starland Regional Emergency Advisory Committee, as well as the *Terms of Reference* for the Starland Regional Emergency Management Agency. In addition, he reviewed the *Starland Regional Emergency Management Partnership Agreement*. Manager Riep noted that if Council adopts a motion to proceed with the formation of a Regional Emergency Management Committee, a bylaw will also be forthcoming in this regard.

Ultimately, they are doing a province wide promotion to all municipalities to hopefully gain a financial commitment from them in the amount of \$2.00 per capita. Ms. Ison Reilander departed from the meeting at 1:40 p.m.

2012 Emerging Trends Seminar Council was reminded that the Brownlee LLP 2012 Emerging Trends Seminar is to be held in Calgary, AB at the Carriage House Inn on Thursday, February 2nd, 2012, commencing at 8:00 a.m. Reeve Hoover and Councillor Marshall noted that they will be unable to attend due to the conflict with the ASB Provincial Conference.

Alberta Animal Services Contract Correspondence was received from the Alberta Animal & Municipal Enforcement Services, advising that Starland County's contract with them is up for renewal. They noted that they have made a few updates to the contract as follows:

- 1) The minimum holding time has been increased from three days to five days, however, the Municipality is only responsible for boarding fees if the animals are unclaimed.
- 2) They updated their fee schedule for 2012. The patrol fees increased 3% in accordance with the cost of living, however the court fees, special patrol rates and dog boarding rates remained at the same cost.

Assistant CAO Bremer advised Council that all the gravel suppliers in the Handhills had been requested to submit a price for the supply of 150,000 cubic yards of 3/4 inch crushed gravel at the 4-20 spec, as well as 20,000 cubic yards of 1½ inch crushed gravel at the 4-40 spec. with access to same by May 1, 2012. Five quotes were submitted by sealed tender, with the low quote being received from Mixcor Aggregates, at \$9.39/cubic yard.

and that these materials are to be stockpiled in the Zipper 1 Pit located at the W ½ 7-29-16-W4M; that Mixcor Aggregates will do all work required to put the material in pile at the above pit; that Mixcor Aggregates will do sieve analysis on this material as it is being crushed and will make these results available to the County at no charge; any other testing is the requirement of Starland County; and Starland County will also be responsible for all work related to moving the material such as loading, haul road maintenance, etc.

AB Transportation Bridge Branch re: Management of Bridges on Access Roads to Hamlets/Villages Correspondence was received from the Office of the Bridge Manager, Alberta Transportation, advising Starland County that they recently clarified that, in accordance with current legislation, bridge structures located on access roads to towns, villages and hamlets are the responsibility of the local municipality that they are located in. They have updated their Bridge Information System to show that Bridge File 70701 is under Starland County's control and management now and we will be responsible for ensuring it is inspected by certified bridge inspectors within the specified inspection cycle, maintaining this bridge structure and replacing it when necessary. Funding is available for eligible bridge structures on a priority basis through the GAP funding program and they noted that it is likely that structures on access roads will be considered a high priority for funding.
