CAO Report

Chief Administrative Officer Ross Rawlusyk reviewed his CAO Report with Council. Highlights of his report included the following:

- The yearend audit preparation process is still ongoing. Endeavour Accountants are scheduled to complete the 2011 Audit requirements from April 2nd to 5th, 2012;
- · The contractors are working at correcting items noted on the deficiency list for the Administration Office construction. The sea cans have now been emptied, however, most of the contents are temporarily stored in spare rooms in the Administration building and need to be filed away;
- · Stantec has now completed and submitted our bridge file inspections for 2011. We were fortunate to receive late March funding approval for BF 9665 to do an Engineering proposal for bridge file repairs (NW 3-32-16-W4M);
- Progress is ongoing with the new WebGIS/Vehicle Tracking system that has been in development for the last year and a half. We are at the point of substantial completion of the WebGIS module outlined in our original scope of work and thus far it seems to be meeting expectations. Progress has been slower on the Vehicle Tracking system where some unanticipated problems have surfaced. Further work is required to recreate a database and software package;
- Munson Fire Department will be celebrating their 100th Anniversary this year and they have requested funding assistance from the County for the purchase of drink mugs with the Munson Fire Department logo and Starland County logo on them;
- The Road Tour will be held on March 23rd, 2012;
 CAO Rawlusyk noted that on September 20th, 1912, the original Star Land No. 307 was created. It included Townships 31, 32, 33 in Ranges 19 & 20; part east of the Red Deer River of Townships 31, 32 and 33 in Range 21 and the part east of the Red Deer River

Ambulance Services Issues

CAO Rawlusyk provided Council members with their convention binders for the upcoming 2012 AAMDC Spring Convention. He noted that they are also enrolled in the Alberta Elected Official's Training Program, which will run from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. on Monday, March 19th, 2012.

Chief Administrative Officer Rawlusyk discussed issues regarding the Badlands Ambulance Services Society Board and also provided copies of their bylaws for Council's review. He also noted that the Hanna Ambulance Society will be dissolving, as their workers voted to form a union and will now be under Alberta Health Services.

HKRWSC re: **Grant Application**

CAO Rawlusyk advised that the Project Proposal submitted by the Henry Kroeger Regional Water Services Commission to the Natural Resources Canada ecoENERGY Innovation Initiative Demonstration Component for a Utility Stabilization Project (HKRUSP) was not approved. They will however, maintain this proposal in a stand-by list, should funds become available at a later date.

Land Acquisition Policy No. 320-2

Council reviewed Starland County's Land Acquisition Policy No. 320-2. Assistant CAO Bremer prepared a summary of land sales within Starland County and noted that the present rate of payment for acquisition of land appears to be much lower than the actual rates that land is selling for. Council reviewed this information, noting that the County should increase this rate together with the minimum payment per acre in this policy.
