Attendance of PWS Pratt & PW Report

At 10:35 a.m., Public Works Supervisor Pratt attended the meeting and reviewed his Public Works Report with Council. Highlights of his report included the following:

- All staff completed fire extinguisher training;
- Regular road and equipment maintenance is ongoing;
- 220 miles of roadway have been gravelled, which includes the 2012 gravel program and add-ons. There is approximately 9 miles left to do;
- There is only about 200 cubic yards of 1½" gravel left at the Gallagher Pit which will be cleaned up as soon as the weather permits;
- Al suggested that Council consider stockpiling some gravel in the northern part of the County this fall, due to the road bans on SH851;
- Thomas Hodge is now enrolled in his second year of his Heavy Duty Technician course.

CAO Report

Chief Administrative Officer Ross Rawlusyk reviewed his CAO Report with Council. Highlights of his report included the following:

- CAO Rawlusyk discussed a water finance research study which he recently reviewed;
- Suncor will be making their formal development permit application to the MPC's from Starland and Special Areas on October 30th. They have booked a room at the Ramada to present their application to the respective planning groups. Following the application presentation, they will be touring the Wintering Hills Facility to showcase their development in the County of Wheatland;
- The fall session of the legislature is scheduled to commence today at 1:30 p.m. The Government is planning a schedule of new Bills to be introduced;
- With regards to the recent appeal received for a development on the NE 1/4 32-29-20-W4M, the Subdivision and Development Appeal Board for Starland County ruled the appeal to be valid, but did decide that the decision of the Development Officer to approve the development conditionally was the correct one. The primary reason for the decision was that the intended use is a permitted use, and the MGA notes that no appeal is available if the issuance of a development permit is for a permitted use, unless other provisions of the Land Use Bylaw were either relaxed, varied or misinterpreted. The Board determined that no variances were applied;
- He attended the Duke of Edinburgh Bronze Award presentation ceremony in Drumheller on October 17th, 2012. The majority of students receiving awards were from Starland County;
- An Alternative Energy Symposium will be held on November 1st, 2012 at the Delia Community Hall from 4 p.m. to 8 p.m.

AAMDC re: Fall Convention

Information was received from the Alberta Association of Municipal Districts and Counties with regards to the upcoming 2012 Fall Convention. Together with the Draft Convention Program, copies of the financial statements for the AAMDC, Jubilee Insurance Agencies and Prairie Fuel Advisors Ltd. were included for Council's review. CAO Rawlusyk also reviewed the resolutions which will be presented at the convention.

Attendance of Manager Riep & Municipal Services Report At 1:10 p.m., Manager Riep attended the meeting and reviewed his Municipal Services Report with Council. Highlights of his report included the following:

- They located a water leak on the Craigmyle Regional System last week north of Ben Smyth's farm. It was caused from a poor fusion joint on the line that appears to have been leaking for some time. Repairs were made and the line was restored the same day;
- He attended an information session hosted by Henry Kroeger

Commission for municipalities receiving water from the commission. The purpose of the meeting was to go over the implementation and risk assessment of HKRWC system on the water treatment portion of their operations. He noted that they are required to complete a risk assessment of each of the water systems by December 2013;

- They are in the process of installing a 6" main isolation valve on the Munson water transmission line feeding Munson. This valve is necessary to isolate those portions of the line that will be impacted by the road construction;
- He met with representatives from Delia with regards to a proposal for a fire hall design;
- He made a presentation at a recent SDAB Hearing held in respect to an appeal made to a development permit issued;
- In respect to the Stop Work Order for the development of a sand extraction pit, he has since received an application for the development;
- The Fire Protection Committee Meeting has been re-scheduled to Thursday, November 29, 2012 at 7:00 p.m.
