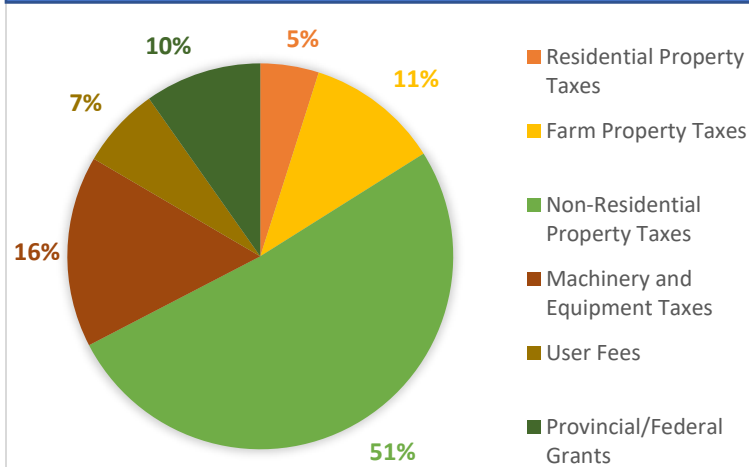

Class 4 – Machinery & Equipment	19.6185	20.1666	2.8%

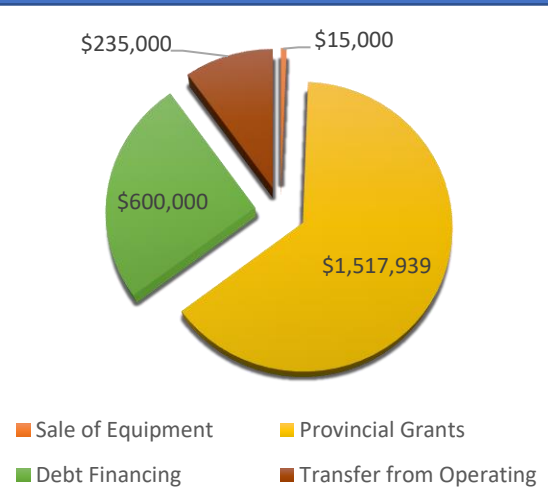

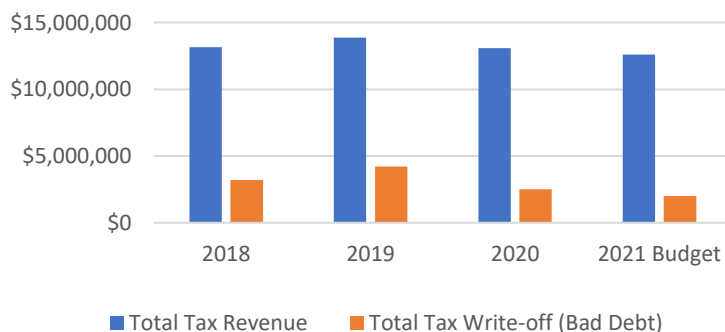
Where the County's 2021 Operating Revenue Comes From

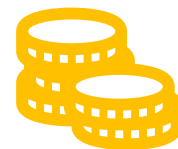
