Must be able to lift 23 kg. Consideration will be given to candidates who are currently enrolled in agricultural related training and to those with a valid pesticide applicator licence or willing to obtain required certifications/licences. Employment will commence on or near May 1st and end approximately August 31st, 2025.
