## BYLAW NO 1043 OF STARLAND COUNTY IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, CANADA

A Bylaw of Starland County in the Province of Alberta, Canada, to authorize volunteer firefighters to use flashing green lights in their vehicles.

WHEREAS, by authority of an amendment to Section 59 of the Highway Traffic Act, the Council of Starland County duly assembled enacts as follows:

- All volunteer firefighters may carry on or in a vehicle other than an emergency vehicle, a lamp that produces intermittent flashes of green light and may operate the lamp if the vehicle is proceeding to a fire or other emergency.
- 2. No person other than a volunteer firefighter shall operate a lamp that produces intermittent flashes of green light.
- Nothing in this Bylaw shall be construed so as to permit a full-time or volunteer firefighter to operate a vehicle in contravention of the Highway Traffic Act, the regulations under that Act, any other provincial legislation of regulation, or any Bylaw of Starland County.
- This Bylaw shall come into force and effect on the final date of passing thereof.
