**CAO** Report

Assistant Chief Administrative Officer Shirley Bremer reviewed the CAO Report with Council. Highlights of the report included the following:

- The new Land Use Bylaw is ready for review by Council and a summary of the changes will be presented later today. The Bylaw has been under development for a number of years and represents a significant number of hours of work by administration staff.
- We have now received word that our 2016 Safety Audit has been approved with a passing mark of 86%.
- Administration is currently undergoing preparation for the upcoming financial audit review process.
- In response to AUMA's advocacy, Municipal Affairs has agreed to modify the viability review process so that it is more timely and efficient by combining several steps and providing more advisory support.
- Alberta's Solar Installation Incentive Program has been delayed. The repeated delays of this program are beginning to have a negative impact on the solar industry in Alberta.

Mayors and Reeves Meeting The Mayors and Reeves Liaison Committee Meeting is scheduled for Monday March 20, 2017 from 3:00 p.m. to 4:00 pm. This will be followed by the Genesis Reciprocal Insurance Exchange meeting.

FCM 2017 Conference The conference program for the 2017 Federation of Canadian Municipalities Conference was released and events and study tours will have to be booked soon.

Attendance of PW Supervisor Pratt and PW Report At 10:00 a.m. Public Works Supervisor Al Pratt attended the meeting and reviewed his Public Works Report with Council. Highlights of his report included the following:

The Public Works crew has been busy with a number of activities

including cutting trees and firewood, plowing and sanding, removing beaver dams and gathering up fire extinguishers to be re-certified.

- Grader Operators have been plowing their divisions and touching up intersections.
- Gary and Kevin have been doing regular maintenance and minor repairs on the heavy duty equipment. They are looking for direction on the future of Unit #70 as the maintenance cost on the unit has been increasing.
- Buck continues with regular maintenance on the county light duty fleet.
- Brenda has been doing permits for service rigs and watching the roads to see if road bans should be put on.
- Al has been working on year end paperwork, doing job descriptions with Chris and monitoring the Burfield and Miracle Mile Slides.

Attendance of MS Manager Riep and MS Report At 11:10 a.m. Municipal Services Manager Riep attended the meeting and presented the Municipal Services Report. Highlights of his report included the following:

- Glen is working with MPE Engineering on several water projects. Revisions are being made to the scope of work for the Fire Hall to allow for a water connection which does not interrupt construction. Also they are working on the replacement waterline for the CLV system.
- All of the fire extinguishers are currently being re-certified. The process takes a couple of days to perform and then to redistribute each unit
- Glen has been working with Palliser Regional Municipal Services on the update of the Land Use Bylaw which will be implemented in the spring.

Land Use Bylaw Review At 11:30 a.m. Cynthia Cvik, PRMS, attended the meeting and reviewed with Council her summary of the major changes being included in the County's updated Land Use Bylaw. Overall she noted the changes expand and clarify the definitions while also adding and assigning purposes to land use districts. Additionally the Bylaw deals with a number of current issues such as alternative energy and floodway development. The new Bylaw will require a number of zone changes for individual properties as well as community consultations over the next couple of months. Cynthia along with administrative staff will be working to consult with the public and recommending changes to the document before final reading of the Bylaw is given.

Fire Hall

Legislative Services Manager Kreke reviewed with Council the recently received cost estimate for the Munson Fire Hall. Currently the Fire Hall is estimated at \$2,448,700. This estimate excludes finishing the 2<sup>nd</sup> floor and portions of the site work to be carried out by Starland County. BRZ Architecture has noted that this number is likely high by 10% to 30% and we will not know until the bid process is completed and design specifications are finalized. Additionally the Fire Hall Committee has compiled a number of items that could potentially reduce the cost further which will be discussed in the near future. The Fire Hall Committee is also proposing that we remove the truck fill building and cistern from the Fire Hall construction program and locate a smaller building in close proximity to the Fire Hall. This change would allow for a smoother construction process as well as a number of cost savings due to the reduced building standard and other possible design and installation efficiencies.
