POSITION TITLE: Public Works Labourer

DEPARTMENT: Public Works

REPORTS TO: Operations Foreman

SUMMARY OF POSITION:

The Public Works Labourer is responsible for providing a variety of construction, snow/ice removal, maintenance and repair services to roads and adjacent public property for the safety and convenience of the public.

RECOMMENDED TRAINING & QUALIFICATIONS

- High School Diploma, GED, or Equivalent
- Class 5 drivers license
- Knowledge of road construction and maintenance activities
- Knowledge of road maintenance and construction standards, by-laws, and other applicable legislation
- Light equipment operator experience that provides the requisite knowledge, skills and abilities for the job
- Safety Training: including Safety Orientation, First Aid, WHMIS 2015, National Safety Codes, and others as applicable

KEY DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

1. Responsible for conducting general maintenance functions for roads and public works operations such as:
 - Construction projects and preparation
 - Maintaining roads in good condition for safe, hazard-free driving
 - Maintaining bridges
 - Gravel spreading
 - Repairing and installing signs etc.
2. Maintains landscaping in healthy, attractive condition
3. Maintains a good condition of roads during winter months by sanding and salting of roads or side walks, snow plowing and shoveling
4. Drive various trucks and equipment to transport and load and/or unload materials such as hot mix, dirt, rock, wood, etc at a designated highway construction site

5. Erects traffic signs near construction areas and flags traffic through and around construction or work areas
6. Mow grass along roadsides, trim trees and cut bushes to ensure roadsides are maintained
7. Assist with installing culverts and proper signage
8. Perform toolbox meetings, pre-trip and post-trip inspections daily
9. Must ensure a solid understanding of and comply with the principles of Starland County's Safety Policy and Safe Work Procedures, Policies and Regulations and have their subordinates to follow the same
10. Must be able to follow workplace safe work procedures, policies and regulations and have their subordinates to follow the same
11. Perform all other duties assigned by the Public Works Director, Operations Foreman, or the Chief Administrative Officer

SAFETY COMMITMENT:

Employee is responsible for full cooperations with all aspects of the health and safety program, including compliance with all rules and regulations, and for continually practicing safety while performing their duties. This position requires operation of County Vehicle, making it a safety sensitive position, so drug and alcohol testing is required on hiring.
